Kindergarten Enrollment

Enrollment takes place on Wednesday and Thursday, March 7 and 8 from 9 AM—11 AM and Noon—2 PM. To be eligible for kindergarten, a child **must be 5 years old on or before August 1, 2018**, and legally reside within the Lake Central School Corporation boundaries. Parents must provide their child's original legal birth certificate (no hospital copy), two proofs of residency *(i.e., home ownership papers or rental agreement, and one current utility bill verifying address),* valid Indiana driver's license or state ID with the current address, and in the case of divorce or separation, custody papers. Bring your child with you to enroll, as they will be given a general kindergarten screening.

Parents of incoming kindergarten students are invited to attend a preenrollment informational meeting on Wednesday, February 21 at the Lake Central Freshmen Center LGI room at 6 p.m. Please enter at Door E. The purpose of this meeting is to highlight various aspects of the upcoming enrollment day and Kindergarten Programs.
