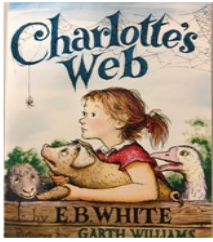

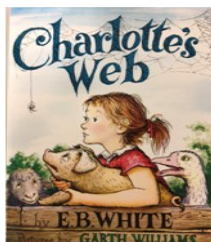
Picture retakes will be on Tuesday, October 30. If your child is getting retakes, please have them bring their original photos with them on the day of retakes.
